WIGGLE CADDIS

1. Hook: 5262 or 101 Size 14 or 16
2. Body: Orange dubbing under palmered brown hackle
3. Thorax: Speckled soft hackle
4. Wing: Light elk hair
5. Indicator: Burnt orange Antron over wing

MYSIS SHRIMP

1. Hook: 2312 Size 16
2. Thread: 10/0 white
3. Body: Pearl Flash-a-boo
4. Thorax: White Antron over white thread. Single red thread over
5. Eyes: Small black rubber legs
6. Head: White Antron

SMOKE JUMPER

1. Hook: 3769 Size 18
2. Thread: Dark brown
3. Thorax: Dark brown or dark grey CDC puffs
4. Head: Dark brown or dark grey puffs

MUDDLER MINNOW

1. Hook: 5263 Size 6
2. Thread: Brown 140 denier
3. Tail: Barred Turkey Quill
4. Body: Flat Gold Tinsel
5. Wing: Barred turkey quill
6. Under Wing: Natural squirrel
7. Collar: Natural deer hair
8. Head: Natural deer hair

STONEFLY

1. Thread: Brown 140 denier
2. Tails: Goose biots
3. Body: Hair's Ear Ice dub
4. Over Body: Mottled Bustard Thin Skin
5. Ribbing: Brown vinyl D-rib
6. Thorax: Same as body dubbing
7. Over Thorax: Thin Skin

PYRITE CADDIS

1. Hook: 2488
2. Thread: Black
3. Body: Gray dubbing
4. Ribbing: Fine flat gold tinsel then black hackle
5. Beads: Chartreuse then black tungsten
6. Head: Midge hackle between beads

PARACHUTE DRY FLY

1. Normal. Just showing technique for any parachute dry fly
